State law requires that we also report additional information to you. Our school currently receives students from the 4 district elementary schools and assigns them in heterogeneous class groupings. Adrian Middle School 5-6 works in conjunction with Adrian Middle School 7-8 and the Trenton Hills Learning Center to assist with educating students with learning disabilities. Currently 7 students attend these programs. Our school improvement plan focuses on the following core subject areas: Mathematics – increasing student proficiency in the computation of fraction multiplication, addition and division, Writing – supporting the main idea with factual information, Science – identifying the components of the scientific method in relationship to providing documentation of results and Social Studies – identifying the major historical events and individuals that lead to the establishment of the United States of America. Our core curriculum is designed to meet the GLCEs as assigned by the State of Michigan and may be accessed by contacting Matthew Schwartz. Our parent teacher conference attendance averaged over 80% from the fall and spring sessions.
